Definitions:

Insured services: Services, including their constituent elements, listed in the *Health Insurance Act* and the Schedule of Benefits publicly funded under the Health Insurance Plan, on the condition that the service is being provided to an insured person.

Uninsured services: Services provided by healthcare providers that are not publicly funded (e.g., prescription refills over the phone, copy or transfer of medical records, etc.).
